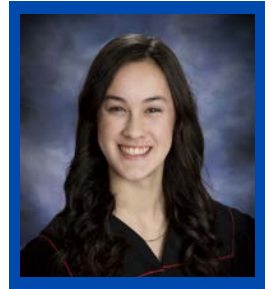
2022 Founders Scholarship Award Recipients

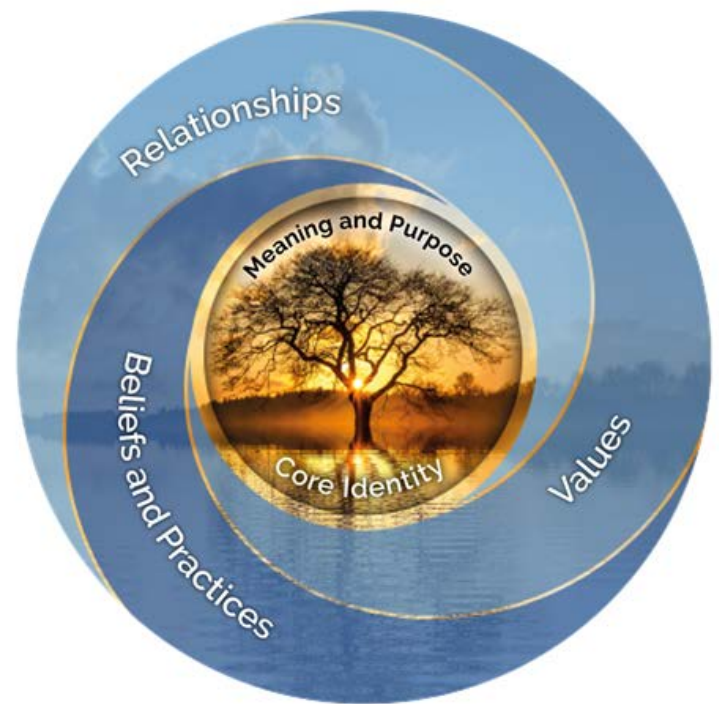

Spiritual Care Report

The NB Spiritual Health Network (NBSHN) functions as the provincial coordinating committee for the delivery of spiritual care across NB's Regional Health Authorities. It is comprised of spiritual care practitioners and managers from both Horizon Health and Vitalité Health networks, along with representatives from the Catholic Health Association of NB and the Department of Health. One of the NBSHN's goals is to provide spiritual health education for the health care community and their community partners. Throughout the past few years, they have sponsored conferences and workshops on spiritual caring at the end of life, grief, spiritual resilience, Indigenous spirituality, and gerotranscendence. This year, they will host two sessions on the important research presented in "Spirituality in Serious Illness and Health" from the Journal of the American Medical Association.
