


How much time have you experienced homelessness in the past year?










Do you have access to health services? E.g. Screening-PAP, prostrate, mammograms, blood tests?




Do you have access to medication (e.g, for birth control, blood pressure, methadone, insulin, etc.)?



In the last 12 months, have you accessed Addiction and Mental Health Services in your region?










